


FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SS0036BK SPINDLE-SLIDERS BENELLI 1130 CAFÉ RACER '05



THIS KIT CONTAINS THE ITEMS PICTURED AND LABELLED BELOW. DO NOT PROCEED UNTIL YOU ARE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT.

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike.

THE PARTS SHOWN MAY BE REPRESENTATIVE ONLY (FOR CLARITY OF INSTRUCTIONS ONLY)





LEGEND

 $\overline{\text{ITEM 1}} = \overline{\text{M6}} \text{ NYLOC NUTS (x2)}.$

ITEM 2 = M6 WASHERS (16mm OUTSIDE DIAMETER) (x2).

ITEM 3 = PADDOCK STAND BOBBINS (B0301) (x2).

ITEM 4 = COMP SLEEVES (CS441) (x2).

ITEM 5 = SPINDLE BAR (SB028) (x1).

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

TOOLS REQUIRED

• Socket set to include 2x 13mm sockets and wrenches

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Fit one nut and washer on spindle-bar (the end with shorter thread) and engage the nut so the plastic insert of nut is fully engaged.
- Feed spindle-bar with nut and washer through either bobbin (B0301 fitted with 1x CS441).
- Feed this assembly through the rear wheel spindle from either side of the motorcycle, ensuring the bobbin locates into the spindle bolt hole.
- Place the remaining bobbin over the exposed end of the spindle bar on the other side of the motorcycle, ensuring the bobbin locates into the spindle bolt hole.
- Fit washer and nut from the kit onto the thread and tighten until both nuts are engaged in nylon and equal amounts protrude from either side. Do not overtighten the nyloc nuts will hold it tight.

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

ARTICLE 1 = M6 Ecrous en Nyloc (x2).

ARTICLE 2 = M6 Rondelles (16mm Diamètre extérieur) (x2).

ARTICLE 3 = Bobines (B0301) (x2).

ARTICLE 4 = Manches (CS441) (x2).

ARTICLE 5 = Axe (SB028) (x1).

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NOTEZ QUE SI LES KITS SONT EMBALLES AVEC DES RONDELLES EN CAOUTCHOUC SERVANT A TENIR LES COMPOSANTS, CES RONDELLES DOIVENT ETRE JETEES !

Outils requis

Clés 2x 13mm

Instructions de montage:

- Passer écrou et rondelle (l'extrémité au filetage le plus court) et engager l'écrou de sorte à ce que l'insert en plastique de l'écrou soit bien serré.
- Passer l'axe avec écrou et la rondelle à travers l'une des 2 bobines (B0301avec 1x CS441).
- Passer cet ensemble à travers l'axe de roue arrière de l'autre coté de la moto, en vous assurant que la bobine aille bien dans le bon trou.
- Placer la bobine restante autour de l'extrémité de l'axe de l'autre coté de la moto, en vous Assurant que la bobine aille dans le bon trou.
- Passer la rondelle et écrou du kit sur le filetage et serrer jusqu'à ce que les 2 écrou soient bien engagés dans les nylon et que la longueur dépassant de chaque coté soit égal. Ne pas trop serer – les écrous en nyloc fixeront l'ensemble.

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
