

Fitting Instructions for OCG0010BK Oil Cooler Guard APRILIA DORSODURO 1200 2011



In This Kit There Should Be
1x Oil Cooler Guard (OCG0010BK)
4 x Cable/Zip Tie
2x 100mm Lengths of self adhesive Foam

• To fit the oil cooler guard to the bike, cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the oil cooler guard frame, so that they sit between the oil cooler guard and the oil cooler.



Fitting Instructions

• Remove circlip from left hand end of 10mm bar that's sits on top of the oil cooler (See pic)



- Slide out bar till there is enough room to fit the oil cooler guard
 - Don't remove bar totally from fixing
- Fit top of oil cooler guard onto 10mm bar and push back into place
 - Refit circlip






- Remove bolt from location bracket at bottom right hand position of oil cooler
 - Fit guard into place and bolt through bracket and tighten



• Fit a cable tie through the bottom left hand location on the guard and secure into place

R&G RACING RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected). Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor. Goods must be in re-sellable condition, in the opinion of R&G Racing. All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase). The customer must pay any and all carriage charges. No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase. This policy does not affect your statutory rights and does not refer to faulty goods.

Instructions de montage de la protection de radiateur d'huile OCG0010BK APRILIA DORSODURO 1200 2011

Ce kit comprend:

1x protection (OCG0010). 2x bande de mousse adhésive 100 mm. 4x colliers de serrage 4 mm.

Pour fixer la protection de radiateur sur la moto, vous devrez couper et coller des morceaux de 10
mm de mousse au dos de la protection. Ces morceaux de mousse se positionneront entre la
protection et le radiateur.

Instructions

• Retirer le circlips de la barre de 10mm (côté gauche) Voir la photo ci dessous



- Glisser la barre jusqu'à ce qu'il y a assez de place pour placer la protection.
- NE PAS RETIRER LA BARRE ENTIEREMENT
- Placer le haut de la protection sur la barre de 10 mm de diamètre et pousser la barre pour la remettre en place.
- Replacer le circlips



R&G Racing



- Enlever la vis de fixation basse qui maintient le radiateur (voir photo ci-dessous)
- Placer et fixer la protection de radiateur, utilisez la vis d'origine.



• Fixer ensuite la fixation inférieure gauche à l'aide du collier de serrage livrés dans le kit. (voir la photo).
