

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SP0017BK SWINGARM PROTECTORS <u>APRILIA RS125 2006</u>

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

- Place 1-off washer and nut onto spindle bar (tighten until plastic bites into thread) and feed through either bobbin (nut goes into the 20mm counter bore)
- Place thin (washer type) spacer on spindle bar on the opposite side of the bobbin (this spacer goes against the swing arm spindle between spindle end and into bobbin counter bore)
- Feed spindle bar complete with nut,washer,bobbin and spacer through swing arm spindle from right hand side of bike (as you would sit on it)
- Place other spacer on the exposed end of spindle bar with smallest spigot going into swing arm through hole
- Place other bobbin onto exposed end of bar (same as R-H side but it covers location spacer)
- Place washer and nut onto exposed spindle bar end
- Tighten the assembly Do not overtighten the nyloc nuts will hold it tight. CONSUMER NOTICE

These terms do not affect the Buyer's statutory rights.

R&G RACING RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected)

Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor.

Goods must be in re-sellable condition, in the opinion of R&G Racing.

All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase).

The customer must pay any and all carriage charges.

No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase.

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
