



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How to install

⚠ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.


Remove the right side cover and the seat.



Remove the lower attachment of the original shock absorber.



When the shock absorber is removed the rear wheel must be supported.





Remove the upper attachment and remove the original shock absorber.

Install the Öhlins shock absorber. The cylinder head should be at the top. Install the o-rings and spacers to the lower attachment, use the original bolt.

• Note!

Lift the rear wheel slightly to fasten the lower attachment.


Install the upper attachment. Use the original bolt.

Reattach the side cover and the seat.

Note!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is being fully compressed or extended.
